

1. What is SAP?

"SAP" stands for Systems, Applications, and Products in Data Processing. SAP is a world-wide market and technology leader in client and server enterprise application software, providing solutions for companies of all sizes and industry sectors. Originally founded in Germany, SAP is now found in over 130 countries across the globe. SAP Americas, a subsidiary of the German founder SAP AG, oversees the company's business operations in the United States, Canada, Latin America and the Caribbean.

2. What is SAP Business One?

SAP Business One is an affordable, integrated enterprise resource planning (ERP) solution designed to enable growing small to midsized enterprises (SMEs) and large enterprises with subsidiary operations to better manage their entire company. SAP Business One provides one simple solution that streamlines business processes, provides real-time information, and helps boost overall business performance.

3. What is the key difference between ERP and accounting software?

Accounting software packages only handle the individual business function of accounting, whereas an ERP application handles the entire range of business functions of an organisation. ERP applications, like SAP Business One, fully integrate all major functional areas of business including: Finance, Human Resources, Sales, Marketing, Logistics, and more. This eliminates the need to support your business with a multitude of manual processes and non-integrated business applications.

There are four License User Types for SAP Business One, each possessing subordinate levels of accessibility. Vision33 Sales consultants work with each customer to recommend license types based on user needs.

Professional User: : A Professional User has access to all modules and functionality within the Business One software. This user is typically involved in the business on all levels such as the CEO, President, Management, etc.

Limited CRM User: Limited CRM User has access to all the major features of the Sales, Purchase and CRM modules. This user is involved with sales, marketing, and customer relations role within an organisation.

Limited Logistics User: Limited Logistics User has full access to all Sales, Inventory, and Production modules and limited access to the Purchase module. This user license is for employees involved in Procurement, Purchasing, and Supply Chain Management

Limited Financial User: Limited Financial User has access to all major Banking, Purchase and Financial functionality in Business One. Typical users include Controllers, Accountants and Financial Analysts.


11. What deployment options are available?

SAP Business One is available as an on-premise or hosted solution through Amazon Web Services (AWS). The decision to deploy the solution using your own infrastructure or through a hosted platform depends on your company's overall requirements, system investment, and long-term goals. As a certified solution for production on AWS, SAP Business One can be hosted using a pay-per-use model which enables customers to pay only for the resources used. 12. How long does it take to implement SAP Business One for my business?

There are several factors that determine how quickly SAP Business One can be implemented and customised to your business. As your implementation partner, Vision33 follows a specific methodology to ensure that you have a clear understanding of the time and resources necessary at the outset of the project. 15. Can I transfer my existing business data into the SAP Business One application?

You need existing business data such as customers, vendors, items, and invoices in order to go live with SAP Business One. Data migration from your old system to SAP Business One can be imported from a text file, excel spreadsheet or manually. To ensure that the migration of data is done as easily as possible, SAP Business One has an add-on called the data transfer workbench (DTW). This tool allows you to import additional master data and transactional data through data extraction, data mapping, and data import – guaranteeing data consistency.

16. What are the basic software requirements to run the SAP Business One application?

SAP Business One has been designed with SMEs in mind. As a result, the application supports multiple technologies to reflect the various levels of IT investment made by fast-growing businesses. At the basic level, the latest release of SAP Business One, Version 9.0, has the following minimum system requirements:

Recommended System Requirements for 30 users

Processor	2 Intel Xeon E7 (or equivalent)
Memory (Ram)	16 GB
Hard Drive	Raid 10 320 GB
Drives	DVD-Rom
Display	1600x900 or higher


Systems with more than 30 users should consider 4 Intel Xeon E7 equivalent processors. Routine SQL Maintenance and engagement with certified SQL Data Base Administrators is recommended. Consideration should be given to add additional processors and memory depending upon the number of mobile users in your company and how many SAP Business One Integration Services are activated (Mobility, Campaign Management, Inter Company, Requests for Quotation, etc.)

If your business is growing faster than your IT infrastructure is able to support or does not have the IT resources to support the implementation of on-premise solution, Vision33 also offers the option to deployment of SAP Business One application as a hosted solution.
