Basebone began as a single entity in Spain and has grown into a group of international companies. Its employee hub remains in Spain, and 10 companies operate across Europe, Africa, and the Middle East.

"When I joined the company, there were 12 people," says Maria Liston, Basebone's CFO. "Now there are about 60. It's been a fantastic journey."

During the early years, Maria and her team used a small accounting system that worked well in Spain—but only in Spain. "It was a nice system, but it couldn't cope with multiple currencies," Maria explains.

The company established a presence in the UK and found inexpensive software. Basebone used the same software when it expanded to South Africa, but there was a snag: The system couldn't handle large numbers of zeroes, so invoices had to be broken into pieces for processing.

"The business was growing, and we were going to add more entities," Maria says. "We couldn't carry on like that."



The Road to ERP

Basebone began its search for new technology in what Maria jokingly calls a "beauty contest."

After evaluating two enterprise resource planning (ERP) solutions, the crown went to SAP Business One for its ability to handle multiple jurisdictions and currencies.

Business ByDesign also speeds up the consolidation process and provides better visibility.


"Even though there are separate companies, they're all in one database, so I can explore everything," Maria says. "That's immediate improvement and lack of error."
