Graduate 1: Industry-Leading IT Company Suffering From Information Silos

A n industry-leading IT solutions provider that specializes in network security and related products has built a successful business over the past 12 years; assisting buyers at each stage of their IT decision-making process through product fulfillment and post-sales support. By consistently meeting its customers' expectations, the company had experienced tremendous business growth - earning recognition on the prestigious Inc. 5000 list, processing more than 2,500 customer orders a month.

Until now, the company had supported its operations with QuickBooks, however as the product lineup expanded, it became harder to keep up with demand. The biggest issue for this fast-growing SME was not having full visibility into their orders and overall operations. They started using additional applications to access this key information, only to discover Quickbooks' limitations in integrating with other applications.

Key Business Challenges with QuickBooks:

1. Lack of Integration with Other Applications

Although the company had been using QuickBooks since its inception, the closed system prevented extending the limited customer relationship management (CRM) functionality of the application.

The limited API resulted in the company manually integrating with separate applications which resulted in information silos.

2. Inaccessible Business Data

The company was running its business with 3 separate applications that did not communicate with each other. This made accessing information stored in disparate location difficult to access.

QuickBooks' limited reporting did not provide the company with access to key information it needed to make business decisions. Lacking key information about its growing customer base, the company knew that without a single integrated solution, it would not be able to support its growth, or the needs of its customers.

3. Poor System Performance

With over 20 users and processing 2,500 orders per month, the IT company's system slowed to a crawl. As an IT solutions provider, its extensive product line of 85 items translated into hundreds of thousands of product numbers. While the company does not carry that many parts in stock, the parts were still required to be entered into the system to create quotes and customer orders.

With 30% year over year growth, the company was encroaching on the maximum number of users to which they could provide licenses. Additionally, the number of products they were loading into the system was resulting in very slow performance.

Key Business Challenges with QuickBooks:

1. Limited Inventory Management

Inventory management in QuickBooks is limited and it is not possible for the supplier to specifically manage the materials side of manufacturing.

This posed as a problem since they needed the flexibility to do light manufacturing but QuickBooks could not provide them with current information about their inventory to minimize holding costs.

2. Unable to Interface with Other Applications

For the cinema equipment supplier another key challenge was that QuickBooks did not provide the ability to integrate with other applications.

Away from a computer terminal, the company did not have access to real-time information needed to make important business decisions. The company faced lost time due to inefficiencies and lack of business intelligence while traveling.

Key Business Challenges with QuickBooks:

1. Limited Financial Reporting

Since QuickBooks does not integrate with other systems, the company would typically accumulate journal entries in one system and then create a manual journal entry in QuickBooks with the same dollar amount - without any justification for matching a specific transaction back to the balance sheet.

This is an issue for accounts such as Goods Received Not Invoiced (GRNI) where businesses are required to keep a constant reconciliation of what they have currently on the shelf.

2. Unable to Make Real-Time Decisions

With QuickBooks, the benefits provider was required to manually post journal entries at the end of each month to create a balance sheet. This process was so laborious that it was not feasible to obtain a snapshot of the company's performance mid-month against its predefined goals without manually recreating all of the journal entries.

This prevented the company from making real-time operation changes to help stay on target to meet its monthly goals.

3. Lack of Accounting Compliance

Like many growing businesses, the primary driver to move to a new business management system was a lack of accounting control – QuickBooks is not SOC or GAAP compliant.

This means that QuickBooks does not offer a way to prevent the modification, or deletion of journal entries. Compliance is critical for growing businesses that are expanding operations and need to report to an increasing number of stakeholders or that need to meet the requirements of an auditing process.
